18 to 20	А	The student shows that he/she deeply masters the subject, beyond the information he has been given. He/she is able to solve problems on his own when necessary. He/she has a critical mind and a capacity to synthesize out of the ordinary (Excellent)
15/16/17	В	The student was above the average standard. No problem or default. The initiatives he/she took were justified. He could analyse the situation on his own as well as synthesize. (Very Good)
13/14	С	The student was interested in the subject. No default could be noticed. Good reaction of the student when a trend is suggested to him/her or when he/she must think of it. He/she sometimes takes good initiatives. (Good)
11/12	D	The student has proved of goodwill or of a certain ability. Very slight problem. and defaults. The critical mind and the ability to synthesize are unfortunately lacking. (Acceptable)
